AI Readiness Sprint

A commercial, operational, and technical read on where AI can create real leverage.

ENGAGEMENT SHAPE

4-6 weeks / fixed-scope sprint

TYPICAL INVESTMENT

Fixed price from A\$35,000. Typical range A\$35,000-\$55,000.

A structured AI strategy sprint for organisations that know AI matters, but need help separating useful opportunity from noise. The engagement audits current capability, identifies high-value use cases, maps build-versus-buy options, and turns the findings into an implementation roadmap that a board or executive team can actually approve.

The sprint begins with discovery across systems, workflows, data, governance, people, and current experiments. The goal is to find where AI can produce measurable advantage rather than performative innovation. Each candidate use case is assessed for business value, implementation complexity, risk, data readiness, and organisational ownership.

The output is designed for decision-makers. It gives executives a practical view of where to start, what to avoid, which vendors and model platforms deserve attention, and how to govern the first pilots before enthusiasm turns into unmanaged tool sprawl.

It is especially useful when teams have enthusiasm but no shared language for value, risk, privacy, integration effort, or operating ownership. The sprint creates a common executive frame before material spend begins.

SCOPE

- AI capability audit across systems, data, workflows, people, governance, and tooling.
- Use case identification and prioritisation using value, feasibility, and risk.
- Vendor landscape review across frontier models, workflow platforms, automation tools, and implementation partners.
- Implementation roadmap covering first pilots, operating model, governance, and investment sequence.

DELIVERABLES

- Current-state AI capability scorecard.
- Prioritised use-case portfolio with value, risk, and complexity scoring.
- Vendor and tooling landscape with recommended shortlist.
- Board presentation and executive roadmap for the next 90-180 days.

BEST FIT

- Executive teams under pressure to define an AI strategy.
- Organisations with scattered AI experiments and no operating model.
- Boards needing a credible roadmap before allocating material spend.
